Objective

Introduction

While FON has conducted research on sexual and reproductive health for years, focus on this area has largely been secondary to other topics such as pregnant women and has primarily taken place in clinical settings. A need to pursue sexual and reproductive health for both men and women, throughout the lifespan, and focusing on health promotion and disease prevention as well as treating illness was identified. The aim of the center is to promote research in the area of sexual and reproductive health, as well as to create programs and interventions for the academic and general community. The center draws upon the expertise of faculty from the divisions of Obstetrics and Gynecological Nursing, Medical Nursing, Pediatric Nursing, and Public Health. In line with the Thailand Ministry of Public Health and the World Health Organization, the Center focuses on 10 aspects of sexual and reproductive health, namely: family planning; maternal and child health; AIDS; sexually transmitted and reproductive tract infections; cancers of the reproductive system; miscarriages, abortions and complications; fertility problems; gender; adolescent health; post-menopause.

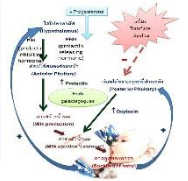
